

BASIC INFORMATION























After a year's break, the FIA European Rally Championship will return to Hungary in 2023. The prestigious event will be held in and around the Zemplén Hills and Nyíregyháza, between 6 and 8 October.

The 2023 event will be centred in Nyíregyháza, where a downtown stage will be held but the field will also visit Rabócsiring in Mariapócs as part of a superspecial stage. The event will be the 2023 season finale, which marks the 70th anniversary of the series.
